## INTRO


 HTx is a European project aiming to create a framework for next generation Health Technology

### **DISCUSSION**

 None of the studied change management models paid attention to all these factors, but all to some. Branding and formal structures were underrepresented and might be areas for improvement. Almost all models paid attention to project management.
